Procedures Performed:

Automated field testing | Excision and/or cautery of non-sinister lesion of the eyelid | Chalazion incision and curettage | Entropion correction | Retropunctal cautery and punctal enlarging procedures | Epilation of eyelashes | Lacrimal syringing | Lacrimal plug insertion | Removal of corneal sutures | OCT scan

Exclusions:

Children under 16 years | Sudden loss of vision. Strabismus/binocular diplopia | Ocular Motility | Neuro ophthalmology problems including squints and double vision | Suspected malignancies | Strong suspicion of Wet AMD | Diabetic screening | Urgent A&E care e.g. red eye, diplopia, acute floaters and flashes and foreign bodies | Suspect or diagnosed keratoconus | Motility problems
